

**NOTICE**  
**CITY OF IRON RIVER**  
**PROPERTY OWNERS**  
**EXCESS TALL GRASS AND**  
**NOXIOUS WEEDS REQUIREMENTS AND PROVISIONS**

Please be advised it is the duty of every property owner in the corporate limits of the City of Iron River to cut, destroy, and remove, from their property all grass in excess of 8" in height, noxious and poisonous weeds growing a minimum of 3 times each year, once not later than June 1, again not later than July 15, and again not later than September 1.

Should the Owner fail to comply within the time limited therein, the grass and weeds will be cut and removed by the Public Works Superintendent, who will keep an account of expenses incurred. The City Council shall audit, no later than the third Thursday in December of each year in which the labor was performed, and if correct, order the accounts be paid from the General Fund of the City. The Clerk will then certify the accounts with the City Assessor. All expenditures shall become a lien against the property upon the city tax roll next in preparation, and collected in the same matter as other city taxes.
